Differences between 1.1.0.2 and the previous Commercial release 1.0.6.9 are as follows:

Differences between 1.0.7.2 and the previous Commercial release 1.0.6.9 are as follows:

1. This release includes support for "Relay Mode", where the global IP address gets "pushed" to the connected TE, thereby allowing more direct access to the UT from the satellite network.
2. Enhanced web MMI configurability in the form of nine "Quick-Connect" setting buttons for quick connection to the network at specified streaming speeds.
3. Additional logging capability for ease of trouble shooting.
4. SIM clock change to make it compatible with more SIM types.
5. Display of SIM IMSI in the 'Properties' page.
6. Refill button on the 'Properties' page
